DETAILS

2nd Lt. Harry Jay Daniels was an Indianapolis native, the son of Harry and Mae Daniels, who attended Indiana University before enlisting at Fort Benjamin Harrison in 1941 and becoming a pilot with the famed Tuskegee Airmen.

While serving with the 301st Fighter Squadron, 332nd Fighter Group, Daniels disappeared in bad weather over Italy on February 23, 1944, and more than 80 years later, he remains unaccounted for.

His name is memorialized on The Tablets of the Missing at Sicily-Rome American Cemetery in Nettuno, Italy
